Easy to Get To, Easy Directions:

For all instructions, once you are on Galiano, we are only one block away from the ferry terminal. Once you disembark from the ferry and proceed down the dock, you will see a lovely resort on your left: that is us! Make your very first left on Madrona Drive, it is a gently sloping one block trip from there, through the gates of the Inn. 134 Madrona Drive.

Because we are so close, many people prefer to park their cars (or take public transportation) and walk aboard. Parking, should you require it, is available at the BC Ferries Terminal (short and long term) or in a private lot on your right, immediately prior to the Ferry causeway. Should you decide you need assistance from the Ferry, please do not hesitate to let us know: a friendly driver will come pick you up in our golf cart.

You will purchase tickets at the ticket booth for the Gulf Islands ferry to Galiano's Sturdies Bay.

Driving instructions from Vancouver:

1. South on Oak Street; it becomes Highway 99
2. South on Highway 99 through the tunnel, to Highway 17 (second exit after the tunnel)
3. Southwest on Highway 17 to the Tsawwassen ferry terminal
4. Take the Gulf Island ferry to Sturdies Bay on Galiano Island.
 - Total estimated driving time: about 40 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

Driving instructions from Vancouver International Airport:

1. Look for destination signs leaving the airport terminal and follow Highway 99 South through the tunnel, to Highway 17 (second exit after the tunnel)
2. Southwest on Highway 17 to the Tsawwassen ferry terminal
3. Take the Gulf Island ferry to Sturdies Bay on Galiano Island.
 - Total estimated driving time: about 25 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

Driving Instructions from Whistler:

1. Highway 99 southbound past Horseshoe Bay, connecting to Highway 1 East
2. Take Taylor Way Exit
3. Cross Lions Gate Bridge
4. Continue through Stanley Park and onto Georgia Street
5. Turn right at Howe Street
6. Cross Granville Street Bridge
7. Turn left at 70th Ave
8. Right at Oak Street (Highway 99 South)
9. Continue through George Massey Tunnel
10. Exit (28) onto Highway 17 to Tsawwassen ferry terminal
 - Total estimated driving time from Whistler approximately 2 hrs 30 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

Driving instructions from Seattle:

1. Highway I-5 North to the Canadian border
2. In British Columbia, I-5 becomes Highway 99
3. Continue North on Highway 99 to Highway 10
4. West on Highway 10 to Highway 17
5. Southwest on Highway 17 to the Tsawwassen ferry terminal
6. Take the Gulf Island ferry to Sturdies Bay on Galiano Island.
 - Total estimated driving time: about 2 hrs 30 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

Driving Instructions from eastern BC through Abbotsford and Chilliwack

1. Highway 1 westbound to Fort Langley
2. Take Exit 66 to Highway 10
3. Highway 10 west to highway terminus at Highway 17
4. Left on Highway 17 to Tsawwassen ferry terminal
5. Take the Gulf Island ferry to Sturdies Bay on Galiano Island.
 - Total estimated driving time from Chilliwack: approximately 1 hour, 15 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

Driving Instructions from Victoria to the Swartz Bay Ferry Terminal near Victoria:

1. Drive from Victoria north on Highway 17
2. Swartz Bay ferry terminal is located 20 miles/32 kms north of Victoria at the end of Highway 17.
 - Total estimated driving time from Victoria: 30 minutes depending on traffic conditions.
